

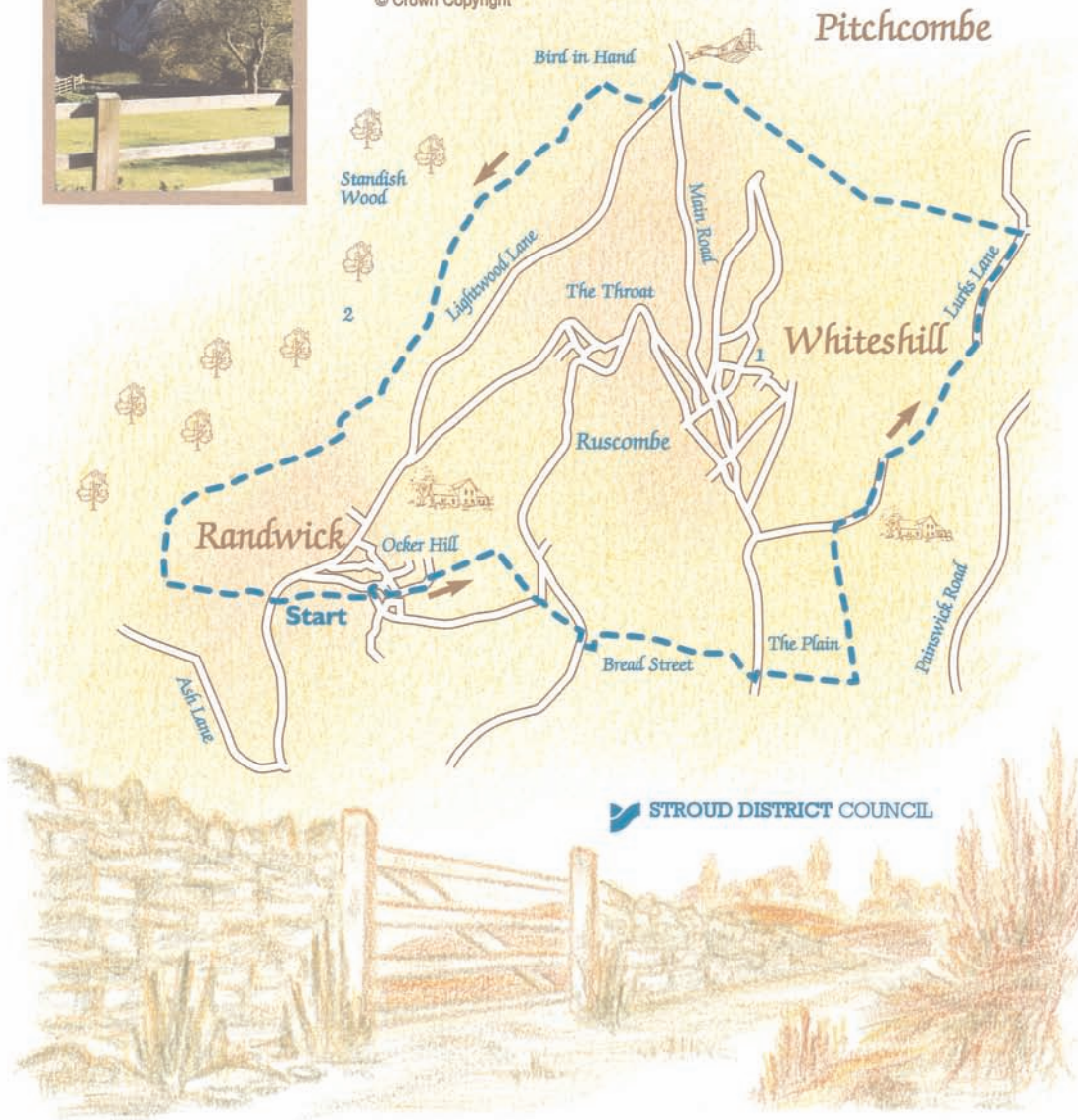

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Randwick, Whiteshill and Pitchcombe

Start . . . The Village Hall, Randwick

Visiting two Cotswold valleys, this is a fairly demanding walk with one very long climb

From the Village Hall, make your way up the road and turn right and then left to ascend Ocker Hill. At approximately 100m cross stile on right into field following the wall on the right hand side, turn right through a gap at end and walk down the field to a stile and out to the road, cross and follow track opposite turning right at the end. Cross the road and down the footpath to the right of the bungalow named St Francis. Over the stile pausing to sight a red bricked wall on hillside opposite. Then turn half left down to a gate and bridge across stream, then quarter right up hill to red bricked wall, cross two stiles and follow path to the road.

Cross road turn left then right down a track by Well Cottage, where track bends sharp right at a junction turn left into field and follow right hand hedge. Cross over a stile to a gate into hard track, follow track to right and then take a left fork. Walk for 150m and just before house cross over stile on right to go down field to right hand bottom corner to stile by gate and over stream. Continue through field keeping to left hand hedge, through gate and along track, continuing ahead at road junction to turn left up hill at cross roads. Through a metal gate and ascend hill through second gate. Still climbing and keeping to left hand boundary skirt a wood and then follow a stone wall to a stile at the very top. Cross and follow a short track to road, cross road turning left and then take the right hand fork to Randwick for about 80m.

Turn right to enter Standish Wood (not footpath into field, but next) and then very shortly left to join the Cotswold Way (way marked arrow with white dot). After 1.2km turn right along a wide track (waymarked blue arrow) and then at about 700m near old quarry walk down bank on left (near a tall stone on right) and cross stile into a field. Keeping to the left hand hedge for about 20m, cross stile on left and walk down through the trees and over a stile to the road and Randwick Church. Follow the footpath which runs to the right of the Church and continue past the school and out into the street. Turn right for Village Hall.
