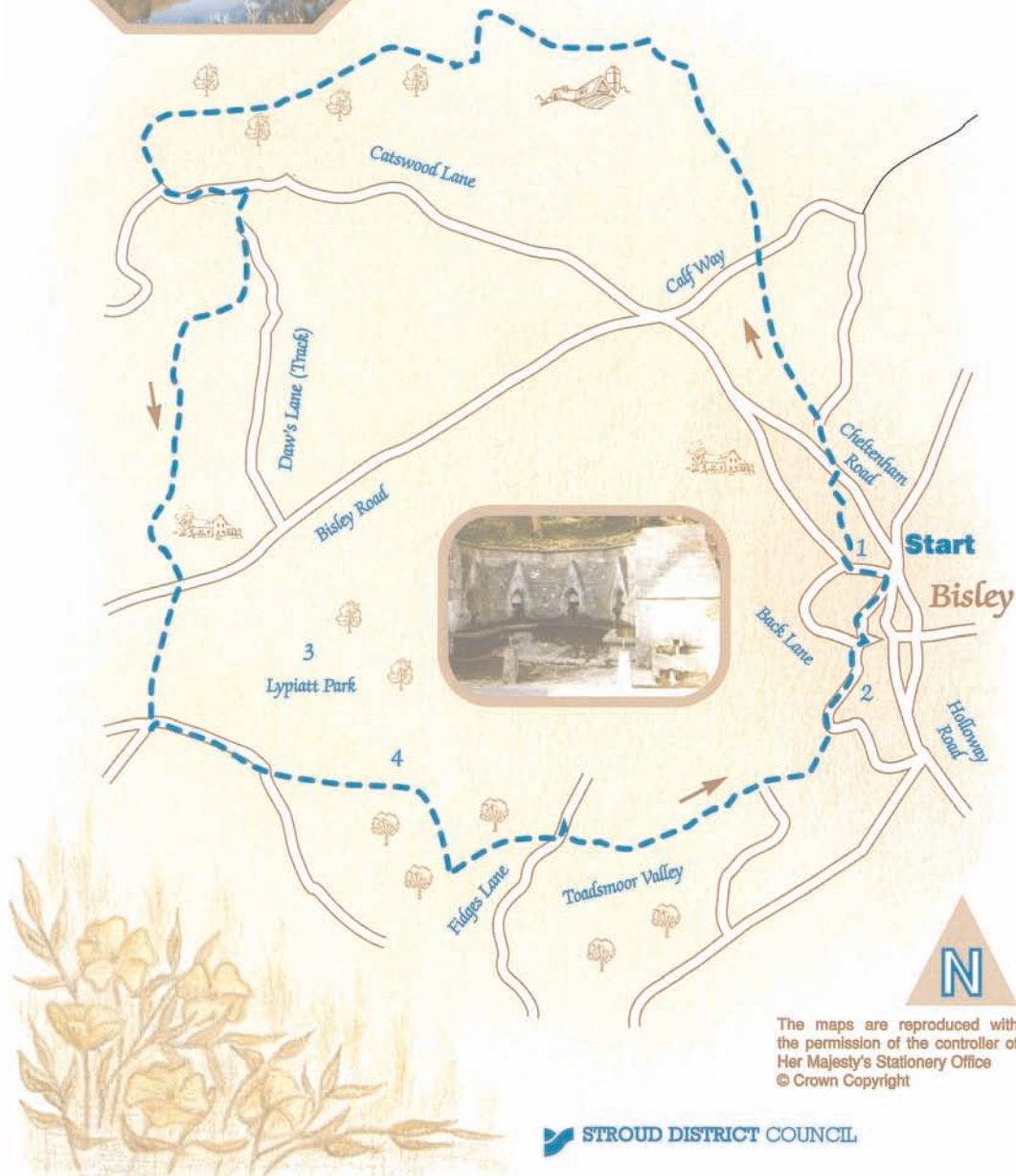


Bisley with Lypiatt

Bisley with Lypiatt

Start . . . The Bear Inn Car Park

This is a varied walk and although strenuous in some places also offers sections between to recover. The small valleys visited are some of the best in the area

From the car park take the footpath sign through houses and keeping to the right pass an old stone stile and through further houses to main road. Turn left, fork right and just after 30 m.p.h. sign take footpath sign to left into green lane, crossing fields to road.

Continue straight over and 80ms. after copse fork left into field over stile. Follow left boundary down to gate, straight across next field to small gate and descend through wood, passing gates on left and right fork left down valley, at end of wood turn up drive to garage, turn left and left again to descend steeply to stream, cross and ascend water course opposite to turn right at top following main woodland path.

At road turn left up hill and turn right at top along farm track. Enter field and continue across centre in a right hand arc to exit into a track in far right hand corner. At end of track turn left to follow boundary to stile in corner (views over Slad), bear left through copse over further stile to ascend diagonally across field to house in top right hand corner. Cross stile and passing through garden continue up drive to road.

Turn right and immediately left down to crossroads, turn left and continue along road to bend and metal footpath sign, turn left through gate into field, follow left hand boundary to stile, cross and descend following fence line into wood. Down steep steps to cross bridge (note of interest) and

descend to main track, turn right and take right fork down to gate by cottage, turn sharp left through second gate, continue up valley bottom to pass through gate and squeeze stile to road.

Turn left up hill and level with cottage turning sharp right to continue on woodland path, emerging from wood into field. Keep stream on right and pass through gate by cottage, over further stile and cross stream. Continue with stream on left to turn left through small gate into green lane. At road bear left then right at 'T' junction. Turn left up Church steps opposite 'Spring Cottage', pass to the right of Church and into road through farm style gate. Turn left at end of road back up to Bear Inn car park.

- Car Parking may be possible at the Bear Inn, but please ask permission from the Landlord.
